2022 Faculty Award of Excellence Teaching

Dr. Joshua Lockyer

Dr. Joshua Lockyer, associate professor of anthropology, won the 2022 ATU Faculty Award of Excellence in the teaching category. Dr. Lockyer joined the Arkansas Tech faculty in 2011. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Arizona. He earned his Doctor of Philosophy degree from the University of Georgia. In 2008-09, Dr. Lockyer was a Visiting Research Fellow in the Centre for Environmental Strategy at the University of Surrey outside London, England and in 2009-10, he was a Postdoctoral Teaching Fellow in the Department of Anthropology and the Environmental Studies Program at Washington University in St. Louis. In 2017, he earned the ATU Faculty Award of Excellence in the scholarship category. In 2019, he was part of a group that earned a prestigious Independent Social Research Fund supported Eco-Communities Residency at Harnack-Haus, part of the Max Planck Society at Frei University in Berlin, Germany. In 2021, his most recent book, *Seeing Like a Commons*, won the Communal Studies Association's Timothy Miller Outstanding Book award.

2022 Faculty Award of Excellence Service

Dr. Erin Clair, professor of English, received the 2022 ATU Faculty Award of Excellence in the service category. Dr. Clair became a full-time Arkansas Tech faculty member in 2010. She holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from Case Western Reserve University, a Master of Arts degree from Texas State University and a Doctor of Philosophy degree from the University of Missouri. She has served as the university's first Director of Composition, the first Director of Operations for the College of Arts & Humanities, and the first Director of General Education. Since 2015, Dr. Clair has served on 40 ATU committees, and has chaired 16 of those. As Director of General Education, Dr. Clair conducted the first-ever ADHE program review of ATU's general education program, created and implemented curriculum-wide assessment procedures to be in alignment with HLC best practices, created the university's general education website, and is overseeing a comprehensive revision of the general education program---a process that hasn't been undertaken at ATU in 30 years. In addition, Dr. Clair founded and coordinates the Faculty/Staff Well-Being Series, which offers resources and weekly, monthly, and one-time events to enhance the lives of ATU employees. She also served on the HLC Steering Committee where she oversaw Criterion 3 (Teaching, Research, Services, and Support), which passed reaccreditation with no recommendations. Dr. Clair created the first-ever university-wide Women's History Month Series by bringing faculty from all colleges together to put on events and exhibits during the month of March 2020. This program grew into the CETL diversity badge program, which is a professional development series for faculty. As well, she drafted the first-ever ATU faculty advising handbook, as well as the first-ever faculty advising toolkit and FAQ. Moreover, as ATU prepared for a virtual and hybrid Fall 2020 semester, Dr. Clair taught seven virtual workshops to train faculty in WebEx and videoconferencing skills. When the stresses of hybrid teaching and learning began to rise, she taught multiple professional development workshops on stress management and work-life balance for ATU faculty and students, as well as workshops on meditation at state and national educator conferences. During the summer, Dr. Clair serves as Area III coordinator for Arkansas Governor's School. She also serves the community by teaching yoga and meditation classes throughout the River Valley, and serves as the volunteer coach of the Russellville Roller Girls.

2022 Faculty Award of Excellence Scholarship/Creative Activity

Dr. Rajib Choudhury **Associate Professor of Chemistry**

Dr. Rajib Choudhury, associate professor of chemistry, is the 2022 ATU Faculty Award of Excellence winner in the scholarly and creative activities category.

Dr. Choudhury has served on the Arkansas Tech faculty since 2015. He obtained his Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Burdwan and his Master of Science degree from the Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati. He completed his Doctor of Philosophy degree at the University of Miami.

He was a postdoctoral associate at the City University of New York in 2013–2014 and at the Florida International University in 2014–2015. His research interests combine the design, synthesis and analysis of photoactive compounds and materials. Specifically, he is developing photoactive compounds, luminescent probes and photochromic switches for chemical sensing and signal processing applications. He is the author of more than 25 publications in the areas of chemical synthesis, computational chemistry, photochemistry and supramolecular chemistry.
