Machining Boot Camp

ATU Ozark is offering a Machining Boot Camp, open to industry with employees needing introductory knowledge in machining operations.

- ✓ Costs: No cost to the attendee. A course fee will be charged but will be covered by the Gene Haas Foundation Scholarship.
- ✓ Eligibility: Industry employees needing entry-level skills in machining
- ✓ Dates/Times/Course Length: June 1st – June 29th; Meets each Mon/Wed/Fri from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm (class will not meet the week of June 20th)
- ✓ Location: Paris, AR (Tyson Foods Logan County Career Center), located behind Paris High School football stadium
- ✓ Materials needed: None; participants should wear safety toe shoes
- ✓ Max class size: 8 students (We ask that each industry only sign up 2 employees)

The course will provide introductory classroom and lab skills in the following topics:

- Reading Industry Blueprints
- Use of gauging equipment including micrometers and slide calipers
- Instruction and exercise on how to operate a Haas mill and lathe
- Shop Safety
- Haas Control Panel
- How to work offsets, tool offsets, and make offset changes
